

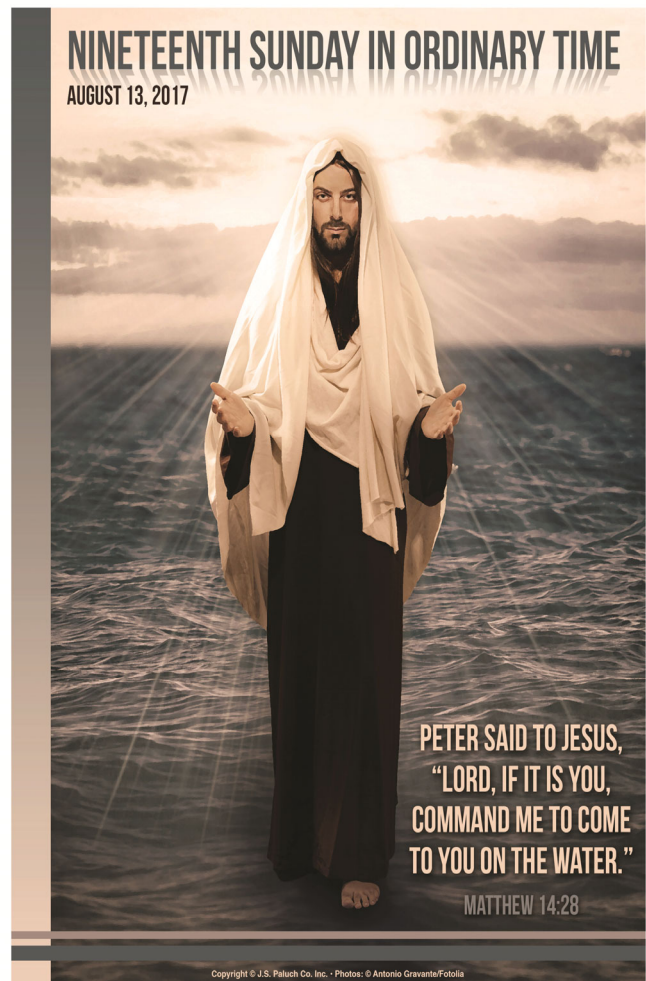

A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN

It's that time of year when parents are taking their kids back to college and when students from pre-school to high school start heading back to the classroom. Here at MQP, our faculty and staff have already been meeting and preparing for the new school year. This Sunday is Back-to-School Sunday, with the Blessing of the Backpacks at 11am Mass and the Ice Cream Social following. Classes begin this Wednesday, August 16, so welcome back to all our students! We offer a special welcome to our new School Principal, Mr. Michael Nieman and to our new faculty and staff members. There is a great spirit in our School, and I am confident this will be a wonderful year of faith and learning!

Our Parish School of Religion begins on Tuesday, August 22, and we welcome back all our PSR students and families for another great year of learning and growing in faith. Parents, if your children are in public school, they should also be attending PSR so that they are being formed in our Catholic faith. There is still time to register for our PSR, so be in touch with Donna Maurer, our PSR Director.

As our children head back to school, what about you, Moms and Dads? How are you going to grow in your faith this year? Is there one step that you can take to grow closer to Jesus and try to love him better? Maybe you can attend the ACTS Retreat this year, or commit an hour to Eucharistic Adoration, or come to the Homelessness Forum on September 27, or attend Mass on a weekday? With children back in school, maybe 6:45 or 8:00am daily Mass would be a great way to begin your day and to pray for your children and family and parish family. I'd especially encourage parents and family members to attend our All School Masses with our school children on Wednesdays at 9:15am, which will begin on August 23. Remember, our Lord is never outdone in generosity; give to God and God will grace and bless you in return.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults will begin in September. The RCIA is a process of faith formation and education for those who would like to join our Catholic Church. If you or someone you know has not been baptized, or has been baptized in another faith, but wants to become Catholic, please consider RCIA. The process of Christian Initiation unfolds over several months, growing in faith and prayer and community and learning about the Catholic faith, Scripture, Prayer, the Mass and the Sacraments, Christian morality, and a host of other topics. RCIA meets on Sunday mornings and culminates with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. I'm grateful to Tim Brown, the new Coordinator of our RCIA, and our entire Team of catechists and sponsors for their faithfulness and dedication for passing on the faith. If you or someone you know is interested in becoming Catholic, be in touch with the Parish Office.

This Tuesday, August 15, is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary, a holy day of obligation. Masses will be celebrated on the holy day at 6:45 & 8:00am and at 7:00pm. See you in Church!

Finally, this coming Saturday, our Parish Council and Pastor's Leadership Team are hosting our annual Parish Leadership Forum. We will gather to pray, to be updated on the "State of the Parish", to hear from the Leadership Team and the Parish Council, and to support one another in faith and community as leaders of our parish. I've asked our clergy and parish and school staff to be present, and every parish ministry, organization, club, and group should send some representative to this meeting. I'll see many parishioners at the Leadership Forum next Saturday morning, and I'd ask every one of our parishioners to pray for our parish, our community, and especially our parish leaders, that we draw closer to Christ, loving and serving as missionary disciples!

August 13 — Faith

How strong is our faith in the risen Christ? According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "faith is the theological virtue by which we believe in God and believe all that he has said & revealed to us, and that Holy Church proposes for our belief, because he is truth itself" (CCC 1814). As missionary disciples of Christ, we must not only keep the faith and live rooted in it, we must also profess it, bear witness to it, and spread it to others. Peter took a leap of faith by walking to Jesus on the water, but he lost his faith when he saw how dangerous the sea looked to him. Similarly, we too often lose faith quickly when the storms of life toss us around to places where we do not like to go. We must pray for Christ to strengthen the gift of faith He has given to us in Baptism so that we might be bolder witnesses to the world.

SCHOOL NEWS

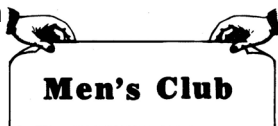
