**A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN**

All of us who are part of Mary, Queen of Peace Parish should foster a great love for our Blessed Mother, the patroness of our parish family. Advent is a particularly special time to renew our love for Mary, our Mother.

Personally, I have long had a deep love for Mary, nurtured in me by my family and my Catholic schooling, as well as my own dear mother, who told me that she had asked Mary to watch over me when she could not. I served as the Associate Pastor of Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in South St. Louis, so I developed a devotion to our Sorrowful Mother, who stood beside the cross of her Son and shared in his sufferings. For many years, I've had a great devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe. Her message of comfort to the distressed people of Mexico has long resonated in my heart and made me aware that Mary, as a Mother, is especially close to her children who are suffering. I've visited the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City and prayed there for Mary's intercession for all the Americas. I have also visited Fatima, and some day I will make it to Lourdes!

While many Catholics would associate devotions to the Blessed Mother with the month of May, I think that Advent is also a time for deep devotion to and reflection on Mary. After all, this is a season of waiting and expectation, and just as the Blessed Mother waited nine months for her Son to be born, and waited for many years for him to manifest his glory, we too wait for the Lord to appear in our lives. Mary appears regularly in the Advent Scriptures, especially in the final week of Advent before Christmas. In your own Advent prayer during these days, ask the Blessed Mother to help make you more patient and loving and to be able to see Jesus in all people and in all things.

Advent also gives us some great feasts of our Blessed Mother, which are approaching in the week to come. December 8 is the Feast of Mary's Immaculate Conception, when the Church remembers and celebrates that Mary was kept free from sin from the very moment of her conception in her mother's womb. In a mysterious way, and in God's own time, Mary shared in the salvific and redemptive act of her Son's death on the cross even before she was born. An interesting bit of Catholic trivia: since we celebrate Mary's conception on December 8, we celebrate her birth, fittingly, nine months later – September 8 is the Feast of the Birth of Mary. The Immaculate Conception is the patroness of these United States of America, so this feast is always a holy day of obligation in the USA. We will celebrate Masses for the holy day this Thursday, December 8, at 6:45am, 8:00am, and 7:00pm. Please make the time for Mass with your family this Thursday.

December 12 is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas. In 1531, Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin, giving him a message of consolation and hope for the indigenous people who were being oppressed by the *conquistadors* and asking that a Church be built in her honor. Juan Diego was a reluctant messenger, but he went to the Bishop with Our Lady's request. Miraculously, in his tilma was imprinted an image of the woman he had seen, a woman with features like his, pregnant with child – Our Lady of Guadalupe. This feast is so important to our Hispanic brothers and sisters, but it should be important to all of us who live on this American continent. The Blessed Mother appeared on our soil, reminding us that we are all her children, that we are all brothers and sisters, and that she has a special need for those who are oppressed. We will honor St. Juan Diego on his feast day this Friday, December 9, and we will celebrate Our Lady of Guadalupe on her feast on Monday, December 12. Next Sunday, December 11, Fr. Aaron will celebrate the 11:00am Mass in both English and Spanish, with special prayers, devotions, and processions in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Please spread the word and please come!

As we continue our Advent journey toward Christmas, may I encourage you to draw near to Our Blessed Mother, Mary, and to seek her intercession and assistance.

Mary, Queen of Peace, pray for us!

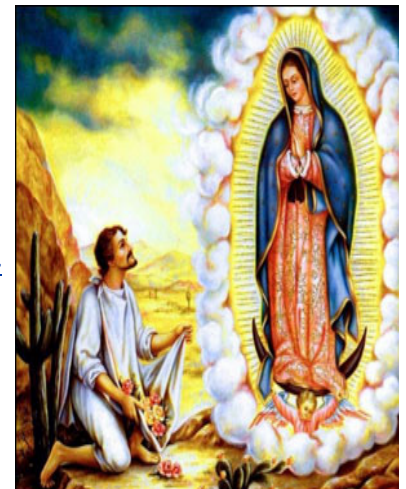
