

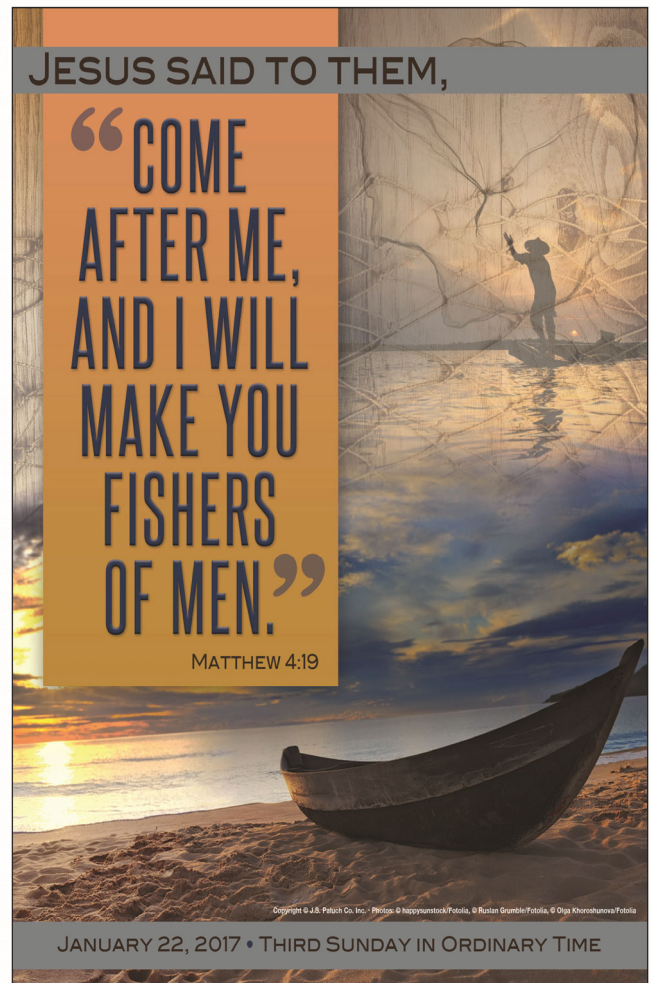

A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN

"The two most important days in your life are the day you are born and the day you find out why." — Mark Twain

Actually, it's dubious if Mark Twain really said that, but it's a great quote nonetheless, and one that I often think about at this time of year. January 13 is my birthday (and this year was a special birthday for me as I hit 50!). And January 16 is the anniversary of my Ordination as a Priest, and I consider my Priesthood to be the reason why I was born. I'm grateful to God and to my parents for the gift of my life, and I'm grateful to God for my vocation. So forgive me for being sentimental, but I mention this really to thank so many of you for your kindness and good wishes to me as I've celebrated my birthday and anniversary this last week. My family was ever so good to me, and so many of you, including our grade school children, offered cards and gifts and good wishes. Most of all, I'm grateful for your prayers, and humbly ask that you continue to support me – and all your priests – with your continued prayers.

Today, January 22, is the 44th anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision which legalized abortion on demand in our nation. Tomorrow is a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. This coming Friday, January 27, is the March for Life in Washington DC, attended by tens of thousands from across the country, including many from St. Louis and MQP. This week, pray for the Pro-Life cause, that all in our nation and our world may respect human life from conception until natural death and that there may be a flowering of human life, human rights, and human dignity throughout our world. I'm grateful to the many parishioners who are devoted to the cause of Pro-Life, but our parish is still in need of a Respect Life Coordinator who can be the contact person for the Archdiocesan Respect Life Apostolate and help coordinate our own parish Respect Life activities. Pray about that this week, and if you feel God is calling you to serve our parish in that effort, be in touch with Fr. Aaron or me.

Tomorrow, January 23, will be the first meeting of our new Parish Council. The way the current Parish Council is structured, four or so members are replaced each January, so a "new" Council begins every calendar year. The new members of the Parish Council are Abby Cole, Brian Davidson, Mary Grassi, Steve Marsh, and Matthew Viergutz. They will join returning members Jeanette Bright, Jody Mayer, Katy Pavelonis, TJ Siebenman, Past President Angie Kimes, and the Executive Committee: Peg Abeln, President; Chris Lawhorn, Vice-President; and Jennifer Grimmer, Secretary. I am so grateful to them and happy for their service and support! The Parish Council members are liaisons to the many parish organizations, committees, and ministries. They also assist me as the "eyes and ears" of the parish, so that I can know and respond to your needs. You may always contact me about parish issues, but you are also welcome to contact any of the Parish Council members with your commendations or concerns. Please pray for our Parish Council.

I am still finalizing my Pastor's Leadership Team. As you may know, I am in the process of discerning and choosing 5-7 parish members who will assist me in the direction and future planning for our parish. With a parish as large as Mary Queen of Peace and without other clergy to assist me, I must rely more and more on the lay members of this parish for advice and counsel. I'm grateful to those parishioners who have offered to be part of this great endeavor, and I ask your prayers and support as we move forward.

Finally, the *Beyond Sunday* campaign continues in our parish and throughout the Archdiocese. In all the parishes of the Archdiocese, over \$90 million has been pledged toward a \$100 million goal to support our Catholic schools and parishes. Here at MQP, our parishioners have pledged over \$600,000 toward our own \$2.2 million goal. Thanks to those who have already made a pledge or a gift. By the end of February, every parish family will be asked to make a pledge to this worthy effort, and I ask for your support.
