

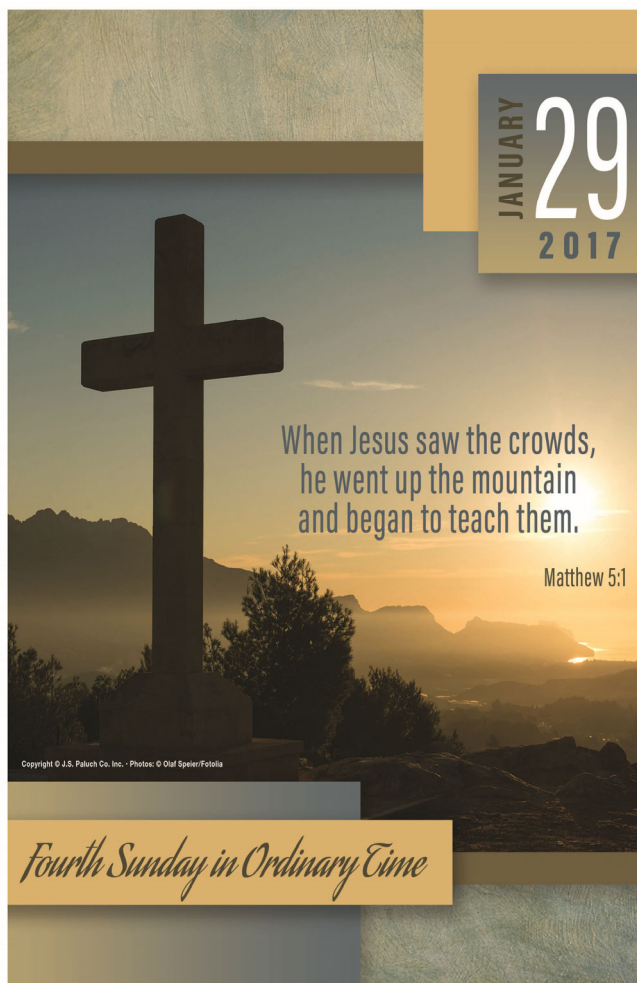

**A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN**

Today is the beginning of Catholic Schools Week, a week set aside to celebrate Catholic education in our nation, and to celebrate our own parish school in particular. I want to encourage all our parish family to join in this celebration by supporting and praying for our parish school!

Too often these days, we're used to hearing bad news about Catholic Schools: the number of students are down; the cost of tuition is unaffordable; the nuns are gone; children don't practice the faith; Catholic schools can't take care of gifted or struggling students; public schools have more amenities. We've heard about Catholic Schools closing or consolidating in our Archdiocese (most recently in South City and in North County) and throughout the nation. Even here at MQP in the year that I've been here, I've heard so many bemoan that our parish school "isn't what it used to be" or that our enrollment has dropped off or that tuition goes up too much too fast.

But Pope Francis, in his beautiful exhortation *The Joy of the Gospel* urges us not to fall victim to spiritual pessimism: "*One of the more serious temptations which stifles boldness and zeal is a defeatism which turns us into querulous and disillusioned pessimists, "sourpusses"* (Yes, a Pope actually wrote about sourpusses!) The Holy Father urges us: "*Let us not allow ourselves to be robbed of hope!*" This is so true and necessary in our world, our society, our Church, our parish, and yes, even our parish school. I am not pessimistic about our parish and school; rather, I believe with all my heart that God has good things in store for us.

Catholic Schools Week is a chance for us to celebrate all that our Catholic Schools have done and are doing: the unique and necessary ways they pass on the faith to the next generation; the high quality academics and excellent standardized scores; the witness of so many dedicated teachers and staff. And so much more! We have so much to be proud of at Mary Queen of Peace School and our whole parish and community should know! Jesus Christ is at the center of our school and is present in every aspect of our school. Our Stewardship program, teaching our children to be grateful and generous, is unique in the Archdiocese and award-winning. Our values based discipline instills character and valuable life lessons in our students. Our school is a pioneer in the Archdiocese promoting and modeling inclusion, helping us meet the needs of every family and student that wants to attend MQP. Our extra-curriculars and our sports programs help to keep our children well-rounded.

While I understand that every school is not a great fit for every child, I also believe that every parent interested in a quality Catholic education in our parish should at least check out and hopefully attend our parish school. I know that there are many choices in Webster, Glendale, and Oakland, and our families have more resources than many, but still, MQP School is of the highest quality and it deserves the support of our entire parish family.

There will be an Open House at our school this Sunday, January 29, from 11:00am until 1:00pm. All are invited to see our school! Any families interested in touring our school should give a call to the parish office and they will make those arrangements for you quickly! Our students will celebrate Catholic Schools Week all week long with Spirit Day, Geography Bee, Crazy Sock and Hat Day, Irish Dance, the DeSmet band and singers, and the popular Family Lunch on Friday.

I hope that all our parish family comes together this week (and always!) in support of our parish school. We have so much to celebrate and be proud of as a community of faith, knowledge, and service.

### Dynamic Catholic, *Alive!*

#### Jan. 29— The Beatitudes: It's about Joy!

Today's Gospel, the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount, reminds us of the challenge of living our faith with a generous and selfless spirit. In his *Commentary on the Sermon on the Mount*, St. Augustine wrote that the Beatitudes provide us with "the perfect standard of the Christian Life." We can come to a greater understanding of our progress and growth in the spiritual life by stepping back and examining ourselves to see when we have been merciful and poor in spirit. It is beneficial for all of us to examine our conscience daily to ask God for the grace to simplify our lives and to be more generous to others. This examination can help us become peacemakers with pure hearts who may have to suffer persecution for the sake of our hunger & thirst for justice. We must remember that the Beatitudes are about joy. Pope Saint John Paul II illuminated this truth when he said, "the joy promised by the Beatitudes is the very joy of Jesus himself; a joy sought and found in obedience to the Father and in the gift of self to others."

### ***Being An Eyewitness to Christ***

*In every American courtroom, from traffic court to Supreme Court, the role of a witness is of primary importance. The witness gives testimony to the truth. The strength of our witness about the living presence of Jesus in our lives is of primary importance to the effectiveness of evangelization.*

*Inspired by the Holy Spirit, John the Baptist testified that Jesus is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world (John 1:29-34). To be an effective evangelizer like the Baptist, we must be able to give our eyewitness testimony about Jesus. Did I hear Jesus talking to me in the music, prayers, readings, and preaching? Did I see Jesus in the Breaking of the Bread and in my fellow parishioners? Do I truly believe that Jesus is the Lamb of God, living within me, who gave up his life so that I could have eternal life? Do I welcome his Holy Spirit into my life and willingly testify about what he means to me before my family, friends, and co-workers?*
