A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN

Merry Christmas! Happy New Year! Blessed Epiphany!

It is a long-standing tradition of the Church to announce the Date of Easter and the other moveable feasts of the Liturgical Year at the beginning of the year on the Feast of the Epiphany. This beautiful tradition, from the days when calendars were not readily available, brings to mind the importance of the rhythm of liturgical time that should have a place in the life of every Catholic. As the Epiphany is all about the manifestation of the coming of God in the flesh, so too we acknowledge how the Paschal Mystery is manifested in the various feasts and times throughout our year. Ideally, the Announcement was chanted immediately after the Gospel at the Mass on Epiphany. Even though this is not common in our day and age, for your knowledge and reflection, I make the announcement here below:

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that,

as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ,

so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also

the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior!

On the first day of March will fall Ash Wednesday

and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the sixteenth day of April we will celebrate with joy Easter Day,

the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the twenty-eighth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the fourth day of June, the feast of Pentecost.

On the eighteenth day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the third day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ,

to whom is honor and glory forever and ever! Amen!

As our Christmas season comes to a close this Monday, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, I'd like to once again express my gratitude to this parish family. On behalf of the other priests, I extend our gratitude for your cards, gifts, cookies, and kind wishes. Thanks to our Parish Staff for their dedication all year through, but especially during the busy days leading up to Christmas. Thanks to all who helped decorate our Church, contributed money for flowers, cared for those less fortunate through our Giving Tree, sang in the choirs or ministered at the Masses, made an end of the year donation, or just came to pray with our parish family Sunday after Sunday after Sunday. How good this parish is when so many work and pray together! As you often hear me say, our Sunday Eucharist is the most important thing that we do as a parish community, and we need everyone present to make it so. How wonderful to see both so many new and familiar faces during these Christmas weeks!

During this month of January, I'm happy to welcome Deacon Tom Mulvihill back to ministry at Mary Queen of Peace Parish. Tom and his wife Molly have been parishioners here for over 30 years, have been involved in so many parish ministries and committees and initiatives, and have been known and loved by so many of you. Tom stepped aside from his ministry as a Deacon for about the last 18 months, and now, with the permission and encouragement of the Archbishop and me, he will be serving our parish community once again. You will see him assisting and preaching at Masses, leading Benediction, presiding at Baptisms, and attending parish meetings and functions. Please welcome him and please pray for him! As we welcome Deacon Tom back to ministry, let me add that I'm grateful, too, to our faithful Deacon Joe Wientge, who also serves our parish with faithfulness and generosity. Pray for all who serve the Church as Deacons, and to any man in our parish who might be feeling the Lord calling you to serve the Church as a Deacon, I know that either Deacon Tom, Deacon Joe, or any of the priests would be more than happy to chat with you. 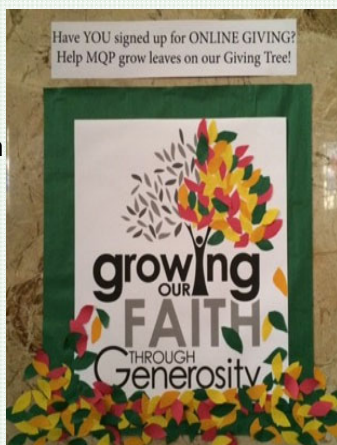

After about a year and a half away, to recharge my batteries, as it were, I am eager to serve this Parish and the Church, and play whatever small role I can in what Father John calls "the great endeavor," namely...our united effort as a Mary Queen of Peace family to be closer to God and closer to one another.
