

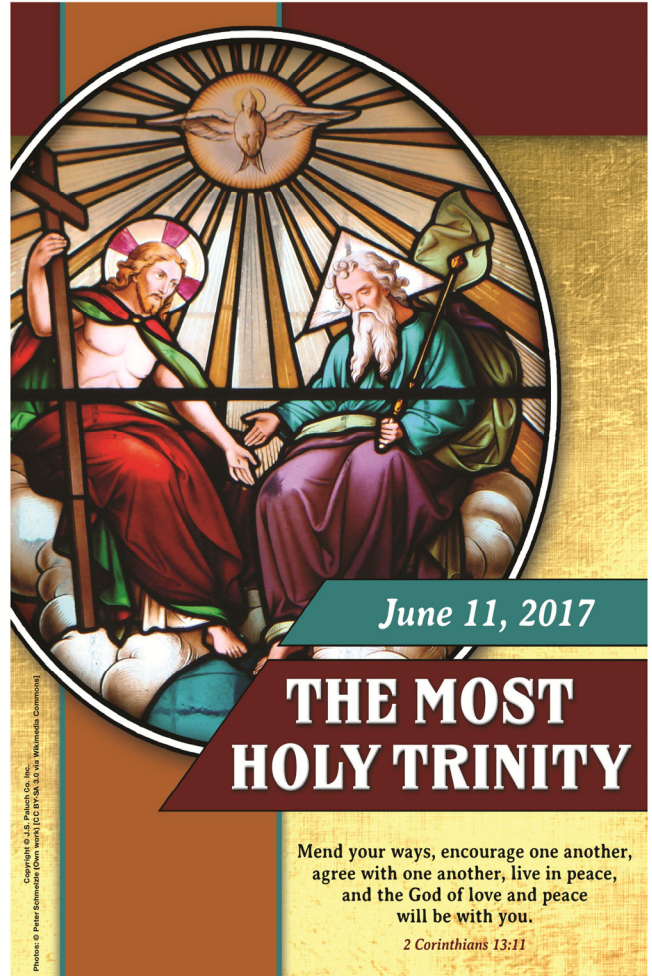

**A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN**

Earlier this year, I established the Pastor's Leadership Team. We have an excellent parish staff that handles the day-to-day operations of the parish and we have an excellent Parish Council that reaches out and supports the ministries and organizations of our parish, but the Pastor's Leadership Team is meant to assist me by setting long term goals and strategies to attain them so that we can be a more amazing parish. The members of the Pastor's Leadership Team are Angela Fiordelisi, Chuck Forthaus, Jim Klimt, Steve Schaefer, and Chandra Tripp. Joyce Schaefer, a professional business consultant and coach, is assisting me as a coach and mentor as we establish the Team. I have asked a three-year commitment from the Leadership Team so that we can work together more effectively and have some short-term and long-term successes.

So what have we been doing? Many of the Team joined me at the Amazing Parish Conference in Atlanta last March. I encourage everyone to check out the Amazing Parish website ([www.amazingparish.org](http://www.amazingparish.org)) to learn more about this model of parish leadership. We have been meeting monthly for a few hours on a Sunday afternoon to establish a good working relationship, including learning our leadership styles, working through conflict, and setting goals and a vision for the parish. We meet every Monday afternoon to pray, review the Sunday experience, and talk about what's happening in the parish for the week. Every day, we pray at 4:00pm for our parish, our parishioners, and especially our parish leaders, that we can grow an amazing parish. Can I ask you to join us in this prayer, at 4:00pm everyday or anytime you choose? If we all pray that our parish will be more amazing, God will do great things in our midst!

We are in the midst of identifying some amazing goals for our amazing parish, and that will happen later this year. Undoubtedly, they will revolve around the Sunday experience, that is, our celebration of the Eucharist on Sundays, the summit and source of our Christian life. The Amazing Parish model supports what study after study has shown about Sunday Mass: the faithful are most influenced by hospitality, hymns, and homilies. Of course we know that the greatest gift of the Eucharist is Jesus Christ himself, present to us in his Word and in his Body and Blood, but we humans cannot help but be influenced by the ministers, the music, and the message.

What is amazing hospitality? A welcoming church is inviting, clean, and well-lit. Ministers of hospitality greet people as they enter and as they exit the church. There is an easy way for visitors to learn about the church and/or register as parishioners. All parishioners are warm and welcoming to one another and visitors.

What is amazing music? Great music leads parishioners into prayerful worship. It directs attention to the altar. It is inspiring and performed well, and people are able to sing along.

What is an amazing homily? Great homilies are passionate, organized, understandable, and relevant.

We intend to evaluate our Sunday experience and its hospitality, hymns, and homilies to see how we can be more amazing. But you can help too! We always need to be more hospitable, welcoming to visitors and kind to one another. We need to be better at singing and participating in the Mass. We need to be more committed to Sunday, knowing that the Eucharist is the most important thing that we do as Catholics and as a parish community. To understand more, may I recommend two books for your summer reading? *Rebuilt* by Michael White and Tom Corcoran and *Divine Renovation* by James Mallon both delve into the threefold importance of the Sunday experience.

As a parish, let us recommit ourselves to making our Sunday experience amazing, and let us pray for one another, that we can be the amazing parish the God wants us to be!

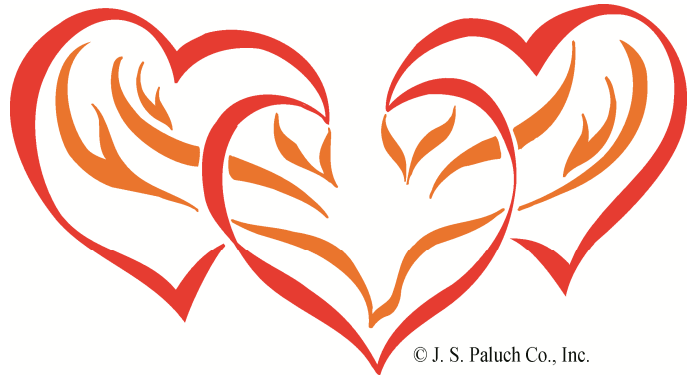

**Dynamic Catholic, Alive!  
June 11 — The Triune God**

I have often heard priests tell me that this solemnity is one of the most difficult days in the liturgical year on which to preach a good homily. It is difficult to preach a homily on such a central mystery of our faith like the Trinity. What is essential to remember for all Catholics is to simply listen to the readings and each of the prayers today for the Mass. Within these texts we can find spiritual insights about the Trinity. For example, the preface for the Mass today provides a great summary of the Church's teaching on the mystery of the Trinity: "For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, and their equality in majesty."
