

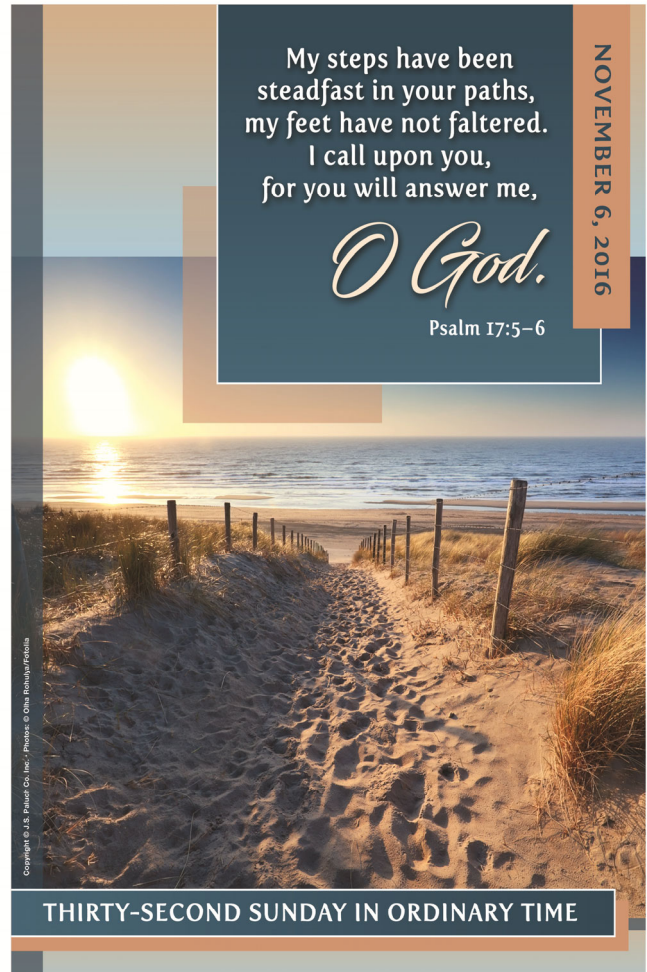

A NEW WEEK — FR. JOHN VIEN

Two weekends ago, I spoke at all our Sunday Masses, encouraging our parishioners to reflect on their own Stewardship, to be grateful for and generous with all the gifts that God has given to us. All our parishioners have received a mailing encouraging them to prayerfully consider God's gifts and their own response. How can you more generously share your time, talent, and treasure with others, especially our parish family? God is never outdone in generosity, so every gift we offer will be returned to us a hundredfold! Next weekend will be our Stewardship Commitment Sunday. You received a commitment form in the mail recently; please return that to Church next weekend.

Our focus during this Stewardship season is to promote electronic giving among more parishioners. Giving online has benefits for you and for the parish. Giving online means that you do not have to write a check, remember an envelope, or decide each week what you can give. For the parish, it is a reliable, recurring source of income that does not change with the weather, vacations, or other schedules. Having more parishioners give online is one of the easiest things that we can do to insure future financial success for the parish. As you've heard me say recently, our financial situation is critical. We are not making our weekly budget and we are operating in the red. This cannot continue without serious consequences. I do ask and encourage you to increase your gift to the parish if you are able, but also to register for electronic giving.

I am happy that 27 new families have registered for electronic giving in the last weeks; thanks to all of them! We are encouraging registration for electronic giving by entering all those enrolled in electronic giving in a raffle. Congratulations to the William Torack family, who recently won a \$100 gift card to Target. In the next weeks, we will raffle another \$100 gift card, and finally a \$500 gift card. To be registered for these drawings, all you have to do is be registered to give online. That's it! Everyone who donates online is eligible to win. Thanks to all those who give so generously to MQP and especially to those who give online!

I'm grateful to those who have expressed an interest in serving on the Parish Council and on the Pastor's Leadership Team. There is still time to be considered for these positions, so please check out information on our parish website and be in touch with me soon.

Let us pray fervently for our nation in these final days before the election. So much attention has been focused on the Presidential race, but of course we should be informed about state and local races, amendments and propositions, and the retaining of judges. Please inform yourself, pray, and vote this coming week. Once again, a prayer for the election:

Lord God, as the election approaches, we seek to better understand the issues and concerns that confront our city, state, and country, and how the Gospel compels us to respond as faithful citizens in our community. We ask for eyes that are free from blindness so that we might see each other as brothers and sisters, one and equal in dignity, especially those who are victims of abuse and violence, deceit and poverty. We ask for ears that will hear the cries of children unborn and those abandoned, men and women oppressed because of race or creed, religion or gender. We ask for minds and hearts that are open to hearing the voices of leaders who will bring us closer to your kingdom. We pray for discernment so that we may choose leaders who hear your Word, live your love, and keep in the ways of your truth as they follow the example of Jesus and his Apostles and guide us into your kingdom of justice and peace. We ask all this in the name of Jesus, your Son!

Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services

Next week our parish will take up the collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission, "Serving those who serve" and its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the United States Armed Forces, enrolled in U.S. Military Academies, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs' Medical Centers, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders, and the families of these populations, as does any other Catholic diocese. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. government, the AMS receives no funding from government or the military for its programs and services, including the Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program, which provides priests for home dioceses and for the military chaplaincy.

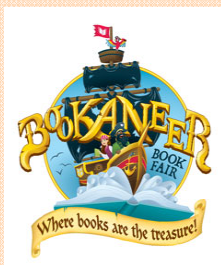

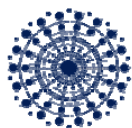
