

## February Parish Council Meeting Minutes

Feb. 27, 2023

**Attendance:** All present. Opening Prayer-Heidi

### **1.Pastor's Report:**

All Things New- 1<sup>st</sup> draft model-Consolidating Parishes & Schools -closed/repurposed buildings.  
2<sup>nd</sup> Draft model- Pastorates- opportunity for extensive cooperation, 4 buildings (all parishes stay open), 1 or 2 priests, 1 parish council.

Stand Alone Parish- 1 building, 1 plus priest, Status Quo.

b. Roof Update-Nothing new to report. Gutters and roof repairs will cost \$150,000- \$200,000. These repairs will last for 20-25 yrs. Work to start in the summer. Jill Redman and Julie Azar are in charge of other improvements. Driveway and fence will be a future project.

c. School Update - 8 candidates for Assistant principal have applied. 2 of the 8 possible candidates have a doctorate. Interviews will start Thursday, and someone will be hired from these. CRE candidate was interviewed today. Enrollment is 340 students: higher than usual.

2. **Fish Fry Update-** Scott- Drive thru needs volunteers. Food ready to go including homemade mac n cheese and green beans. Pre-order thru Wednesday.

3. **Day of Service-**Being promoted on website, in the bulletin, on flock notes and in the MQP weekly starting March 12<sup>th</sup>. There will be different opportunities for hands on service for different ages. Committee Members are needed. Beth to share a name with the current members Heidi, Dana, and Patti.
